Forty years later, I fly with my son and two other fathers and their fifteen-year-old sons to Whitehorse, the capital of Yukon Territory. I descend the river once again, in three canoes all together. Initiation for the child while I, the father, paddle through my own history. Goldrush is a quest from the surface to the bottom of the Lake of Memory. Personal and general, experience and history in one.

This project is an exploration of change and movement. Along the length of the border, across the width of the route and through the depth of time: over two decades.
