Nanda Milbreta is the author and illustrator of her autobiographical debut book Kommunalka Child about growing up in the Soviet Union (first published in November 2020 by Talisar Books in The Hague then in June 2023 by Austin Macauley Publishers in London), and she writes poems and stories for Little Quibbles. Nanda is a poetic observer of the world within and around us, she notes the trifling things and turns them into poetry. From 2007 until 2022 Nanda was part of Neon & Landa together with artist Léon Spek. Their curiosity, passion and research went into sound, light, science and technology. They built sound and light installations with autonomous character and sometimes humorous behaviour. The themes of their artworks were often inspired by natural phenomena, such as (bioluminescent) land and water organisms.






