## SONJA VAN KERKHOFF

I often use text ambiguously as visual-tactile stimuli and conceptual element in my videos, sculpture, installations, performances, prints, paintings, drawings or interactive works Over the years I have approached art-making like a researcher, which for me includes constantly learning new techniques, so these days the sense-idea combinations in my art cross and mix a wide range of media. I began as a maker -- drawing, painting and sculpting -- so often I play with the possibilities in the media during the process of following a script or working out an idea. The result is an artwork that shifts ambiguously between abstraction and ideas. I often use text ambiguously as visual-tactile stimuli and conceptual element in my videos, sculpture, installations, performances, prints, paintings, drawings or interactive works. Often there is a social political personal reference that is also a play on the aesthetic and the multicultural or culture in general. In the Truisms photo-painting-prints the play between languages is not just between the New Zealand (where I was born and raised) Maori and English texts but also between the language of abstract expressionism and the conceptual, in miniature. "Bed Peace" was a performance/installation intervention surrounded by televisions showing videos also part of the Leiden Int. Short Film Festival. More > www.sonjavank.com
