R.B van Heesch (NL, 1991) creates films, poetry and photographs.

R.B. van Heesch (b. 1991) is a Dutch visual artist exploring the world of cinema through themes of spiritual transformation, identity, and the subconscious. By blending fiction with abstraction, his work breaks away from traditional storytelling, crafting immersive, dreamlike experiences. Working with both analogue and digital techniques, R.B. uses cinema as a medium for introspection, stripping away the layers of the self to examine personal and collective spiritual growth. His work challenges the boundaries between reality and perception, questioning how film can not only reflect but also evoke transcendent experiences.

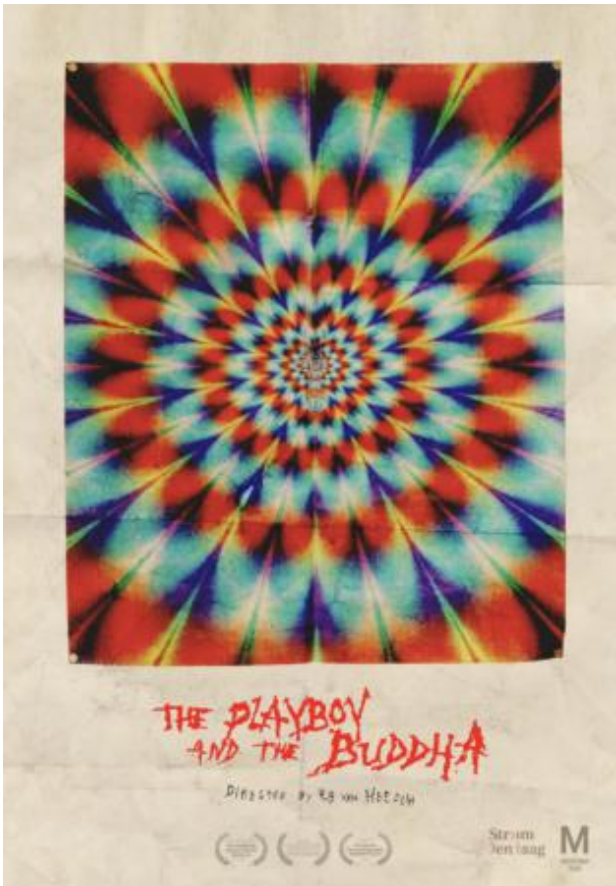

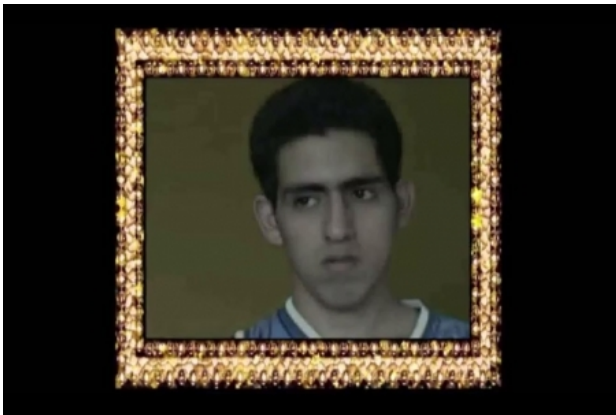

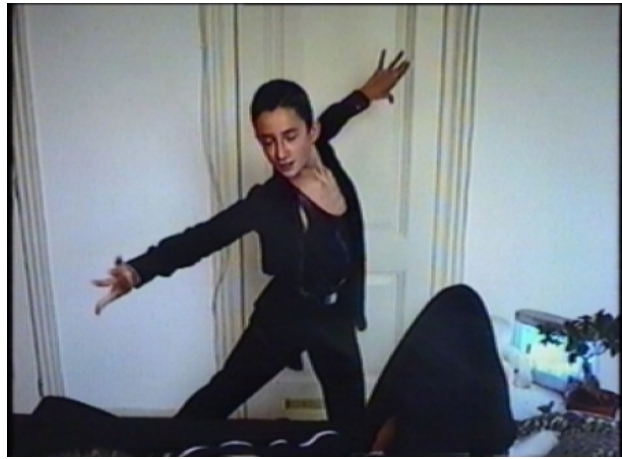
