## JIAJIA QI

A given architectural situation, my own initial intervention, audience-environment interaction, and the 'temporal uncertainty' formed by time-space are all equally important and necessary in my work. My work is just like dust in the room, which has no recognizable outline and is thought to be in the wrong place. It always stands in the middle of its unrelated things, with no recognized past and no predictable future; it is not something that is 'beyond or next' to viewers, but rather something 'within or part' of them. My work blurs the boundaries between artificial and natural, interior and exterior, fictional and factual, in order to decontextualize a disordered moment, stimulating viewers to compare what their surroundings offer up for observation and what they actually observe. My work is a fragile contiguity that is becoming through light and lightness, air, transparency and fluidity, transformation, and movement. It is similar to a blank fragment that exists between everyday experiences and actual reality. This fragment is either too minuscule to be noticed or too habitual to rise to the level of consciousness. I am interested in turning the familiar surroundings into a distant by precisely measuring, calculating, and placing a given spatial setting. What I seek in my work is not about following, clarifying, or determining, but rather how to continue gazing, figuring, and altering. My art, more or less, concerned with 'what is absent', rather with 'what is it'; it is influenced by the cultural-historical context yet indirectly linked in the social-political framework; it wonders about the contingencies of modes of linking instead of providing a certain idea. Artistic practice, for me, is a procedure of creating a form of life, which, like all forms of life, is tentative and uncertain, and progresses through experimentation. I create experiential site-specific installations that incorporate interaction, architecture, and sculptural elements through the exploration and production of time, space, and site.

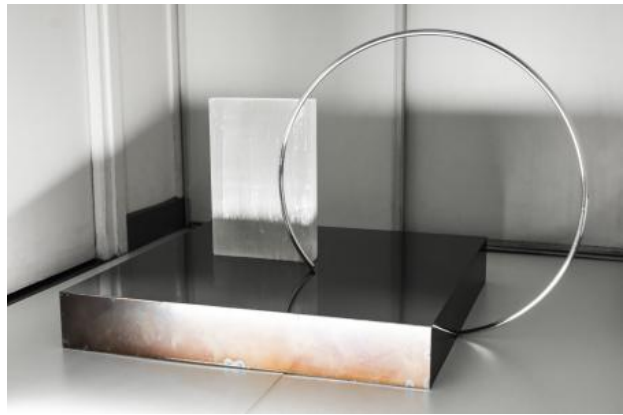

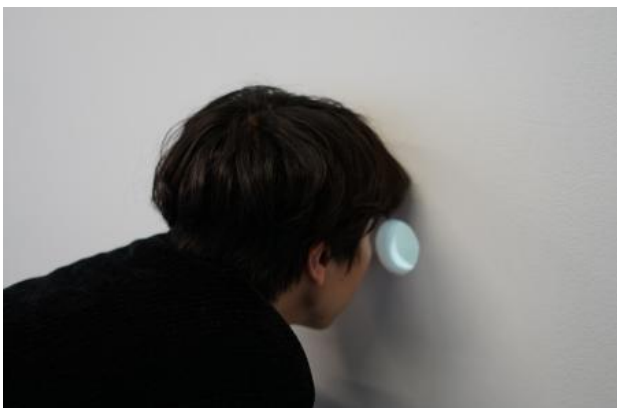

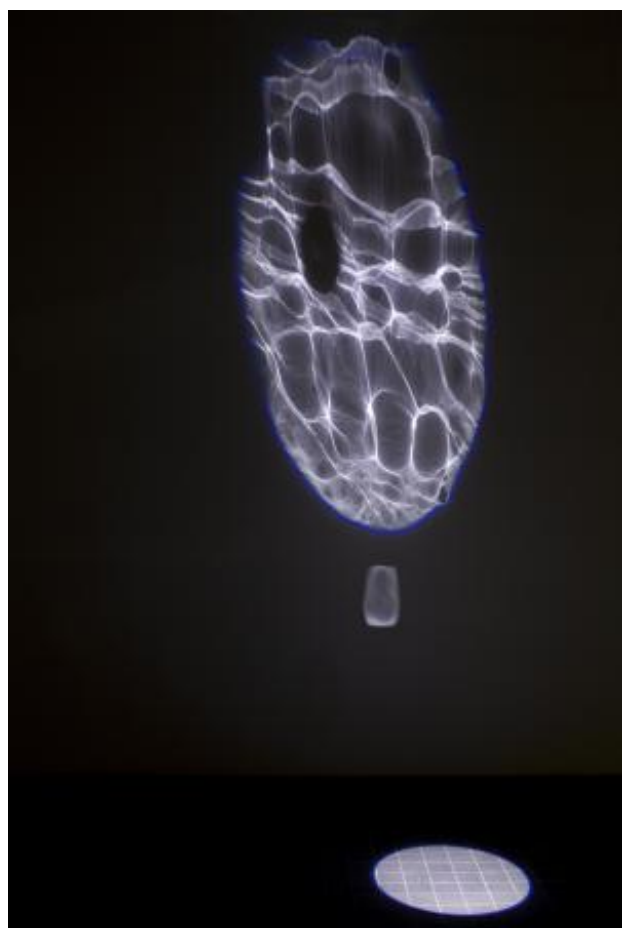
