JEMIMA DE JONGE

"It makes me feel very big and very small at the same time"

Jemima de Jonge is an interdisciplinary artist, who uses immersive film installations to merge her drawings, sculptures, installations, and performances into one gesture. With a cultivated naiveness she blends the physical with the virtual and miniature into real size, creating alienating experiences. The constant personal interplay between the need for control and a longing for surrender has an unavoidable influence on her work. It's a never-ending search for the ungraspable moment when things collide, where friction and uncertainty occur and harmony becomes painful. Her vision is to bring back curiosity in people who seem to have lost it. In which a particular sense of humour plays a significant role. In response to the amount of hyperintellectual art, Jemima strives to create experiences and stories where her references, inspirations, personal experiences and commentary are so intricately interwoven with the work that you can feel them without needing to point them out. Additionally, with the bond created by the viewers' physical relationship with the artwork, she aims to bring you closer to your emotional reactions and role in the piece. Often questioning her own and the audience's sense of self. A small incident can trigger the unfolding of an entire inner world. Minute details and the work as a whole, then start to interact intimately. The perspectives and rhythms vary constantly. They blend into a dance that gives the visitor an almost cinematic experience, inviting them to immerse completely in the work In her videos, Jemima performs multiple roles. She uses her body as a messenger of emotions, stories, and ideas. Central to this is the interaction between the individual and the mass, both of which she embodies. Simultaneously zooming in on details and being overwhelmed by the whole. Her meticulously created world is based on reality, sometimes serving as an escape, at other times expressing longing, and often offering humoristic commentary. WEBSITES
