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YELIM KI

Yelim Ki(KR/NL) is a multidisciplinary artist who challenges the intersections of cinematic images mediated on screen and material reality through video, sculpture, and interactive media. Grounded in animism and media archaeology theory, her work critically examines the promises and illusions of technological permanence.

Yelim Ki takes fiction writing or linguistic structure as a prompt of each project and embodies her interests into audiovisual results through the collaboration with people in various fields. Based on her critical approach to contemporary technological culture, she explores the poetic use of computer languages or materializes 3D digital media into sculptures, creating a structure in which artworks transfer through reality and fiction, media and processes. Ki had a solo exhibition at Bio gallery (2024) and won the Special Jury Prize at Jeonju International Film Festival (2022). Her work has been shown at various venues and events such as MMCA Seoul, e-flux Film & Video Festival, Instrument Inventors(iii), EXiS (Seoul Experimental Film and Video Festival), ACC (Asia Culture Center Cinematheque) and more. Her works are archived in SeMA AA(Art Archives, Seoul Museum of Art), KOFA(Korean Film Archive).

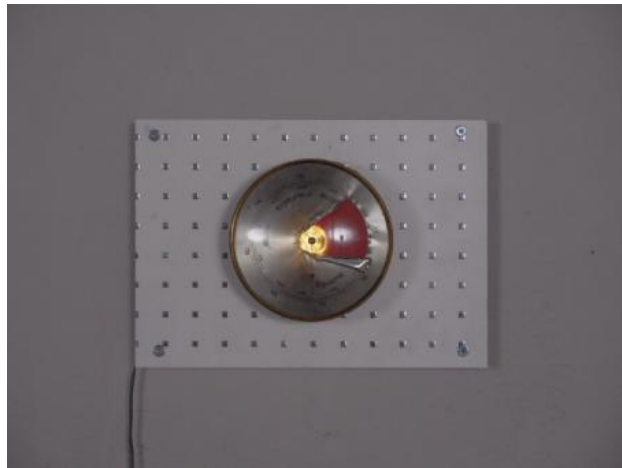

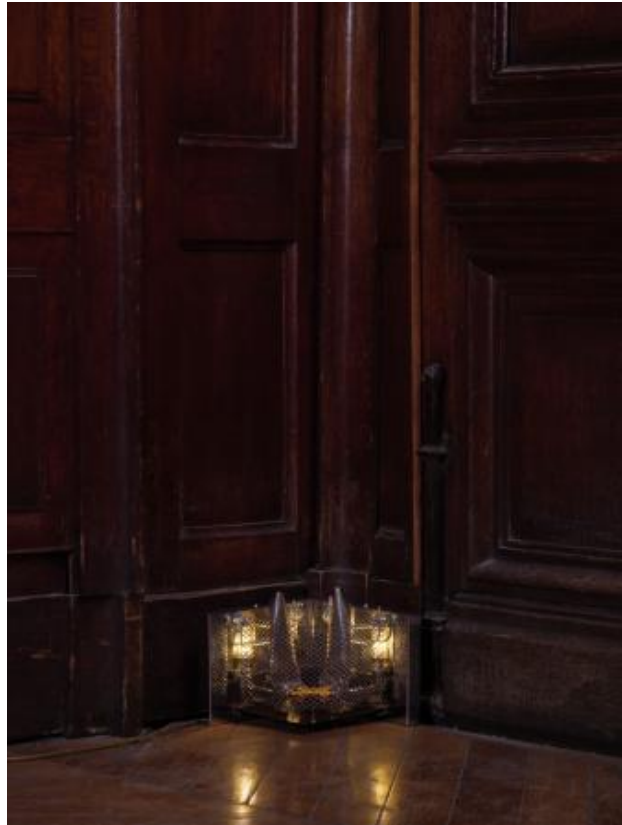

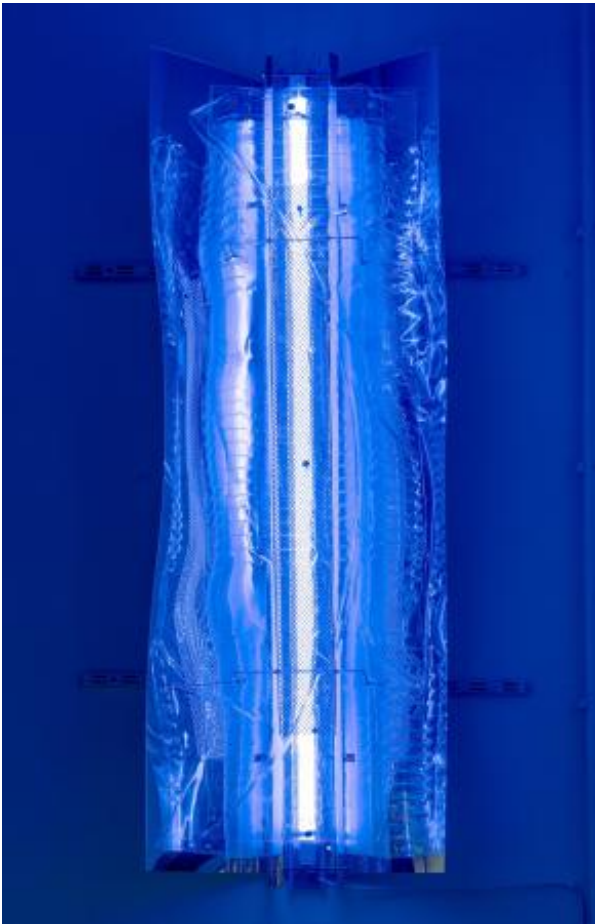
