Yara Chaalan's work explores themes of longing for home while being far from it. With a deep connection to the landscapes of her home country, Lebanon, Yara recreates images of the mountains and sea she misses, often portraying herself as part of these landscapes. During times of war, she has repeatedly depicted her homeland in an idealized light—a place she wishes to remember it as, rather than how it currently is. She speaks and writes about Lebanon as a perfect place drawn from memory, though not as accurately as it may be.
