

LUIZA M MILEWICZ

Light becomes structure—where geometry, rhythm, and perception converge into sculptural experience. My artistic practice centres on light as an active, transformative force—one that shapes perception, space, and emotional experience. Working with LED technology and layered materials, I explore how light can reveal structure, alter atmosphere, and create moments of stillness and attention. Through a synthesis of geometry, colour, pattern, and material, I create abstract compositions that invite sustained engagement. My work draws from both natural systems and mathematical frameworks, connecting organic growth with architectural order and underlying energetic relationships. While informed by principles of sacred geometry, the work moves beyond formal systems to explore tensions between the visible and invisible, and the finite and infinite. Material experimentation is central to my process. I work with plexiglass, expanded polystyrene (EPS), concrete, metal, and fibre optics, combining hand processes with industrial techniques such as laser-cutting and anodising. These approaches allow light to be shaped and diffused with precision while maintaining a strong sensory presence. Produced as limited editions, the works exist at the intersection of art and design. They aim to create contemplative environments—spaces where light is not only seen, but experienced.

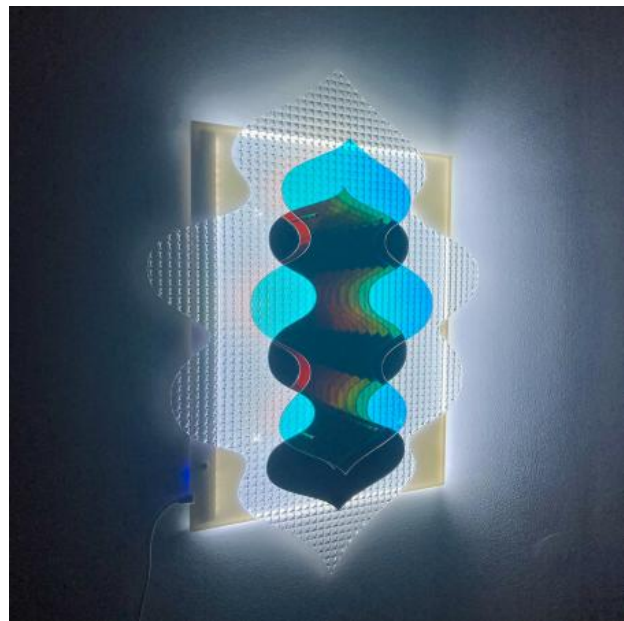
Optical Bloom, 2026

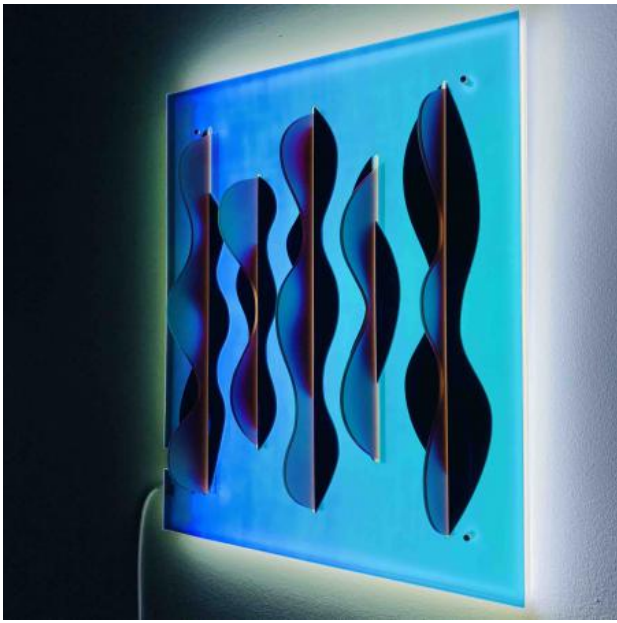
Optical Weave, 2026

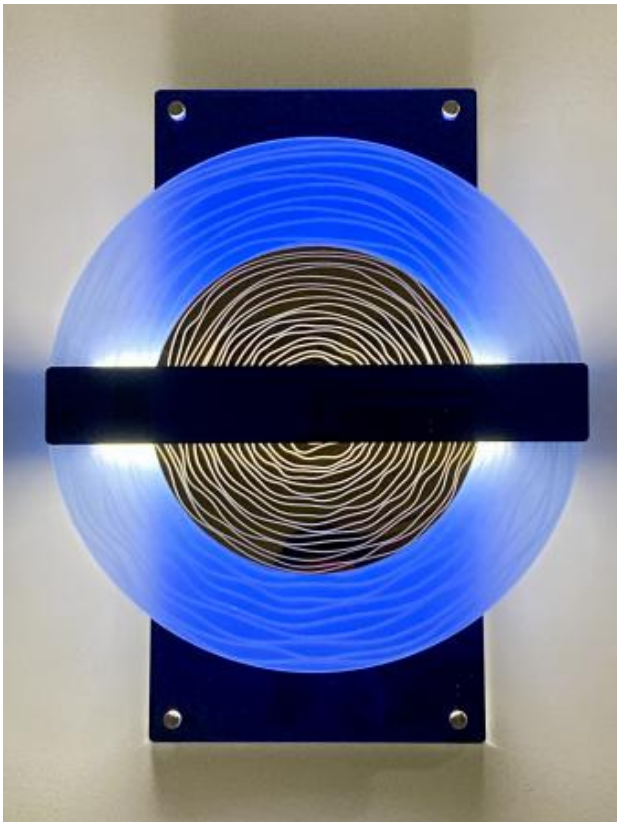
Arabesque Wave, 2024

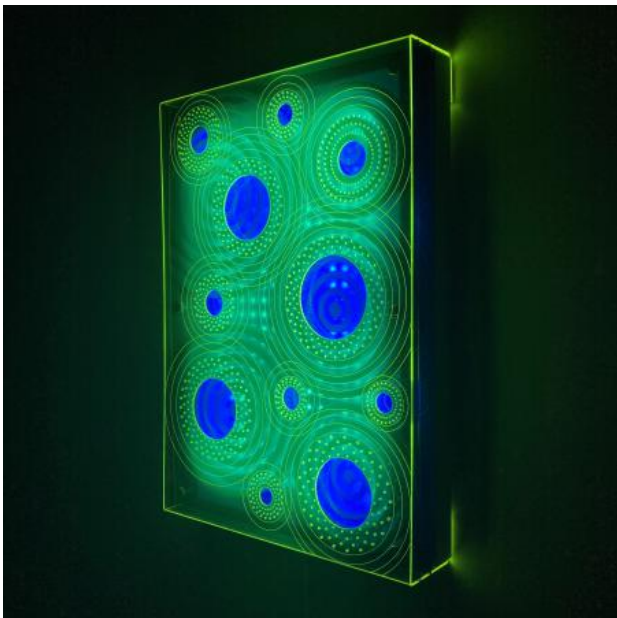
